

Directions to the Biodiversity Research and Teaching Collections



Take the Hwy 6 East Bypass around Bryan/College Station and exit Hwy 60 (University Drive). Turn east onto Hwy 60 and drive approximately one mile. You'll notice a large athletic facility on the right hand side of the road (Veterans Park), our drive is the next paved drive after the park. Our drive is poorly marked (Yellow arrow on map), it is just before the traffic light at Copperfield Parkway. There is a brown and white Texas A&M University sign at the turn for our building (shows up as Old TI Road on Google Earth). Turn right at the sign and drive about a quarter of a mile to the end of the second parking lot (Yellow Star on map) for parking. As you prepare to make this turn, be aware of traffic behind you that are also turning, but not until the next intersection, so they might get close to your tail.

The BRTC is located in the southeast corner (Room 128) of the building. Look for the double glass doors that are clearly labeled Biodiversity Research and Teaching Collections and entrance ramp, you cannot access our area from any other entrance to the building, so if you don't see these clues, you are in the wrong place.
